ACADEMIC PROGRAMS	<p>NSE students, in most cases, may select courses in any of the University's Schools and Departments. There are a few exceptions, for example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Prerequisites must be satisfied for some higher level courses• English writing samples may be required for some classes• Portfolios may be required for some art classes• Auditions may be required for some music classes• Students are excluded from most <u>Accounting</u> classes above the 200-level
ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY	<p>Students from institutions where English is not the language of instruction must demonstrate English language proficiency. Acceptable scores are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• iBT test (internet) minimum score is 70• Minimum IELTS score of 6.0• English 3 Placement Test (E3PT) minimum 55• More information can be found at https://english3.com/english3-proficiency-test-taker.php or www.toefl.org and at www.ielts.org

HEALTH INSURANCE	<p>All Montclair State University students are required to have health insurance. Full-time students are automatically enrolled in the MSU plan and charged for the insurance premium. You have the option to stay enrolled or waive the plan if covered by another carrier. Proof of coverage MUST be provided by completing the online waiver prior to the deadline.</p>
IMMUNIZATIONS	<p>All students are required to demonstrate that they have received the mandatory immunizations. The requirements are listed here. Immunizations are available from our Campus Health Center.</p>
PAYMENTS	<p>Students can make payments to the university by wire transfer or by credit card (fee applies). Instructions can be found here. Payment for housing will be required by the first week of classes.</p>
ON-CAMPUS EMPLOYMENT	<p>Students can apply for on-campus work up to 20 hours per week during semester and fulltime when class is not in session.</p>
