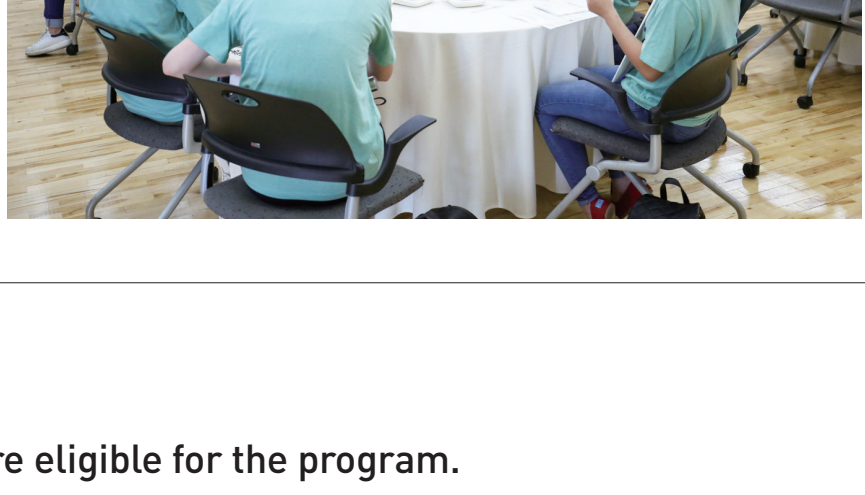

Admission Requirements

* Undergraduates or Postgraduates from all over the world are eligible for the program.

* Seoul International Summer School accepts exchange students from partner universities.

★ Application Process

Step 1

[Step 1 is applicable to exchange students only.]

If the applications are from UOS partner universities, their home universities' International Offices are asked to nominate their students via email to uossummer@uos.ac.kr from February 1 to April 30, 2017.

Step 2

Each of the applicants is required to complete [the on-line application](http://global.uos.ac.kr) (at <http://global.uos.ac.kr>

→ For International Students → Studying in UOS → International Summer School

→ Eligibility & Application) from March 1 to April 30, 2017.

Step 3

UOS Issues the admission letter and invoice, which will be emailed (or mailed if needed) to each applicant and to his/her home university's International Office.

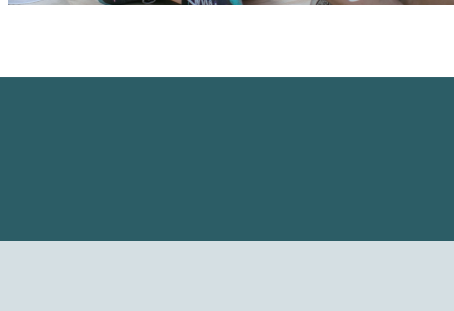
Housing

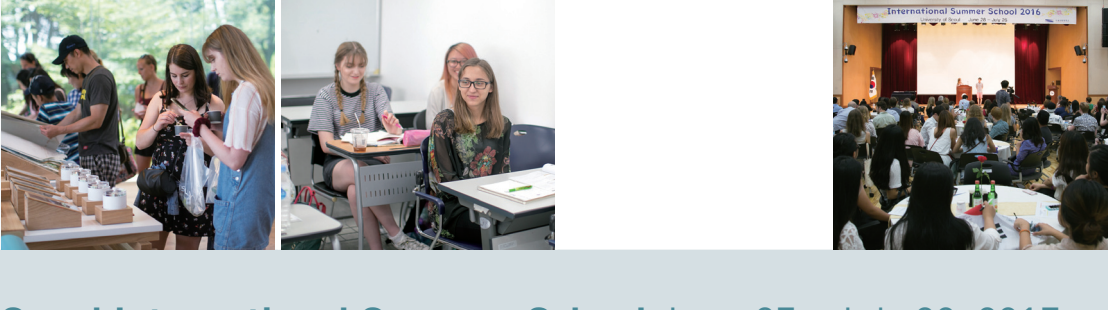
