ACADEMICS

The exchange program at Université Laval is **open to all French Majors and French Minors**. Course of study, however, is primarily focused on the field of **French Translation**. Students must have a high intermediate level of French. An online French placement test is required.

Credit Load per semester: 12-15 credits (4-5 classes)

Language of Instruction: French

Additionally, coursework in French as a second language may be undertaken if a student does not have the required level of French. There is a small fee for these courses.

Application Deadline: March 1st for Fall Semester
or October 1st for Spring Semester
Minimum GPA required: 2.67
