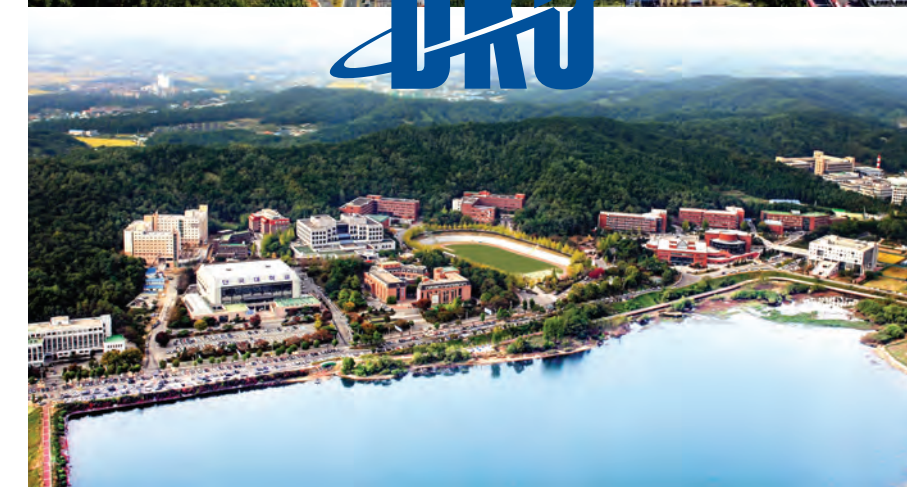

Global Network

Dankook University has extensive relationships with universities all over the world. DKU has formal agreements for cooperation and exchanges with over 200 universities.

Student Exchange Programs

Dankook University has various partnerships with sister universities with bilateral agreements. These partnerships allow students to spend extended periods of time studying at the partner universities, while receiving a scholarship to cover some of the expenses.

Study Abroad

Dankook University offers its students and sister university's students the opportunity to participate in double/triple degree programs and structured partnership programs at the undergraduate and graduate's levels.

Visiting Students

Dankook University is delightfully welcome international talents who want participate a semester or a year. Student will earn credits from Dankook University and it may be transferable to host institution.

International Language Studies

DKU offers global programs for students to get to learn foreign languages at sister universities in the U.S., U.K., Australia and other countries for short term periods (minimum 4 weeks to maximum 8 weeks) during vacation or for an entire semester to take language courses and major courses, and then receive credits upon returning. Students can make selections based on their own study plans and academic achievements, students' travels may also be supported through Globalization Scholarship.

Academic Expedition in Korea for International Students

It offers the chance to gain new expertise on various fields, experience about Korean culture during summer or winter vacation with the collaboration between international and Korean students.

INTERNSHIP PROGRAMS

- On Campus: The international affairs staff conducts internship programs throughout the academic year. These opportunities allow international students to gain valuable work experience in an administrative setting on campus.
- Off Campus: DKU offers a competitive internship program to international students who wish to gain experience in technology, marketing and new venture planning off campus near Jukjeon Digital Valley.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS

International Summer / Winter School

Multi-Cultural Village (EV, CV, SV, GV)

Multi-Cultural Village is a unique scholarship opportunity for college students who are seeking a personal, professional and educational experience in Korea. Dankook University designed Multi-Cultural village to simulate a language immersion environment with Dankook students and international students. Invited international students will lead small groups of conversation classes daily.



Academic Program (AP)

The academic program consists of 4 weeks of intensive classes, taught by international and/or Korean professors in English. Each class meets 4 days a week, for 3 hours a day.

- Students may take up to 6 credits transferable to their home Universities.
- Cultural Activities and Field Trips are available.

Intensive Korean Language and Culture Program (IKLCP)

This program is designed for students who wish to improve their understanding of Korean culture and increase their knowledge of Korean language in a 3-week intensive summer period.

- Students may take up to 6 credits transferable to their home universities

International Summer Research Program (ISRP)

In this program we offer an opportunity to our partner university undergraduate and graduate students to work on special research projects under the guidance of faculty members of Dankook University.

Students are expected to conduct the research on either the Jukjeon or Cheonan Campus on a full time basis under the direct supervision of a faculty or research staff member from Dankook for a 9 week summer session.

KOREAN LANGUAGE PROGRAM

Program Description

The Korean Language Program is designed for foreigners, overseas Koreans, international students and exchange students seeking to better understand Korean language and culture.

Program Structure

- Opens 4 semesters a year - 1 semester for 10 weeks duration
- Runs 5 days a week and 2-3 culture classes per semester are offered.
- Intensive courses on listening, speaking, writing and reading
- Concentration on conversation skills as well as grammar
- TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean) preparation course
